- TrueAim™ dual level trigger for faster, more accurate long distance reads
- Wi Fi 6 and 5G connectivity for seamless indoor/outdoor continuity
- Up to 53 large, glove-friendly physical keys optimized for complex workflows, with the addition of a customizable Datalogic button that can be mapped to the required functions.

The combination of Green Spot and TrueAim enables confident, eyes on task scanning without constant display checks, improving speed, accuracy, and operator confidence.

Falcon X60/65 features an ultra-rugged design engineered to withstand dust, moisture, temperature variation, vibration, and repeated drops.
